

DIVINE MERCY

Next Sunday, the Second Sunday of Easter, is Divine Mercy Sunday. This week we look at the origins of the Divine Mercy Image and the upcoming feast day.

THE DIVINE MERCY IMAGE

The earliest element of the Devotion to the Divine Mercy revealed to St Faustina was the Image. On February 22nd, 1931 our Lord appeared to St Faustina in a vision. She saw Jesus clothed in a white garment with His right hand raised in blessing. His left hand was touching His garment in the area of the Heart, from where two large rays came forth, one red and the other pale. Jesus said to her:

Paint an image according to the pattern you see, with the signature: Jesus, I trust in You. I desire that this image be venerated, first in your chapel, and [then] throughout the world (Diary 47).

The two rays denote Blood and Water. the pale ray stands for the Water which makes souls righteous. The red ray stands for the Blood which is the life of souls. These two rays issued forth from the very depths of My tender mercy when My agonized heart was opened by a lance on the Cross. These rays shield souls from the wrath of My Father. Happy is the one who dwells in their shelter, for the just hand of God shall not lay hold of him (Diary 299).

Divine Mercy Sunday - the Feast of Mercy

During the course of Jesus' revelations to St Faustina He asked on numerous occasions that a feast day be dedicated to the Divine Mercy and that this feast be celebrated on the Sunday after Easter. This Feast was granted to the Universal Church by Pope John Paul II on the occasion of the canonization of St Faustina on 30 April 2000.
