MOST REV VINCENT LONG VAN NGUYEN OFM CONV DD APPOINTED FOURTH BISHOP OF PARRAMATTA

His Holiness Pope Francis has today appointed the Most Rev Vincent Long Van Nguyen OFM Conv DD, as the fourth Bishop of the Diocese of Parramatta. He has been Auxiliary Bishop of the Archdiocese of Melbourne since 2011.

Bishop Long Van Nguyen OFM Conv DD succeeds Archbishop Anthony Fisher OP.

The new Bishop of Parramatta was born in 1961 in Gia-Kiem, Vietnam. He and his family came to Australia as refugees in 1980. After his ordination to the priesthood on 30 December 1989, Bishop Long Van Nguyen OFM Conv DD went to Rome for further studies and was awarded a licentiate in Christology and Spirituality from the Pontifical Faculty of St Bonaventure.

He was elected superior of the Order of Friars Minor Conventuals

in Australia in 2005.

Very Rev Peter G Williams, Diocesan Administrator of the Diocese of Parramatta, warmly welcomed Bishop Long Van Nguyen OFM Conv as the fourth Bishop of Parramatta.

"Bishop Vincent is no stranger to the Diocese. As a Conventual Franciscan Friar, he was Parish Priest of Our Lady of the Rosary, Kellyville (1998-2002)," Fr Peter Williams said.

THE WEEK OF PRAYER FOR CHRISTIAN UNITY IS 8-15TH May 2016.


