During Catholic Schools week, schools will be reaching out to their communities and showcasing connectedness. The Diocese of Parramatta is located in one of the fastest growing areas of New South Wales, with more than 43 000 students are enrolled in local Catholic schools. The Diocese is West of Sydney and reaches from Dundas Valley, West to Katoomba, South to Luddenham and North to Richmond.
