Renewing your Working With Children Check

Many parishioners have needed to undertake a Working With Children Check because part of their ministry involves contact with children. This check is only valid for 5 years, and the first renewals will come due during 2018. There are several steps that need to be undertaken to have your check renewed, but the first (and most important) step is to make sure the Office of the Children's Guardian (OCG) has your current correct contact details. If these are correct, the OCG will contact you to advise the process to renew your check. To check whether they have your current details, logon to www.kidsguardian.nsw.gov.au/check If you need to update your details, do so on that website.
