A MESSAGE FROM CATHOLIC EDUCATION DIOCESE OF PARRAMATTA. A key aspect of the work at Catholic Education Diocese of Parramatta (CEDP) is to build the capacity of diocesan teachers to share their Catholic faith with their students.
