THE STAINED-GLASS WINDOW! - What does it mean? Part 1 of 3 weeks of information



The new addition to our northern window is the major and second part of a three-part stained-glass window. It was planned at the time of the building of our lovely church with the blue section being completed with finances available at that time. During 2018 the parish was gifted with a generous donation from the estate of Father Brian Larkey who, by 1995 and with the support of parishioners, turned the wish for a new church into a reality. This 2nd part has been funded by Fr Larkey with the addition of contributions from individual parishioners in 2018.

Father Larkey had a deep appreciation of the 'Australian' style of Catholicism which is shaped by distance and the environment in which we live. Additionally, he showed a great respect and interest in Aboriginal culture especially in its artistic expression. The fact of our location within the Blue Mountains National Park, a World Heritage area, is a fundamental factor in design.

Elements of our Church reflect these understandings, such as: the ochre-coloured glass in the ceiling, the use of natural elements, the symbolism and decoration of the main doors, the symbols on the altar, chair and ambo; the baptismal font.

THE DIVINE MERCY IMAGE AND THE FEAST OF MERCY

On February 22nd, 1931 our Lord appeared to St Faustina in a vision wearing a white garment with His right hand raised in blessing. His left hand was touching His garment in the area of the Heart, from where two large rays came forth, one red and the other pale. Jesus asked her to paint His image with the signature 'Jesus I trust in You'. The two rays symbolise water, which makes souls righteous, and blood, which is the life of souls. 'These rays shield souls from the wrath of My Father.' (Diary 299). On numerous occasions Jesus asked that a feast day be dedicated to the Divine Mercy and that it be celebrated on the Sunday after Easter. Pope Saint John Paul II granted this Feast on the occasion of the canonization of St Faustina on 30 April 2000.

You are invited to join in praying the Chaplet of Divine Mercy after the 5.30pm and 9.30am Masses next weekend. It only takes about 15 minutes and is prayed using rosary beads.
