BERYL & STAN CALLAGHAN 70TH WEDDING ANNIVERSARY TUESDAY 18 FEBRUARY 2020

Beryl & Stan met dancing in the streets of Penrith the night the 2nd World War ended 15 August 1945. They continued their relationship via long distance, by writing letters, when Stan was sent to Japan for 18mths, between 1946-48, with the BCOF (British Commonwealth Occupation Force). They were married 18 February 1950 & first lived in Canberra whilst Stan was finishing a course following his Army time. Stan built a garage on their land in Glenbrook, of which he hand made the bricks, & they lived in that garage whilst Stan built their house over the next 3-4 years. During that time 3 children were born. Stan was the 1st President of the St Vincent de Paul in Glenbrook. Stan was part of the volunteer groups that built the early school building stages. Stan has also served on many charitable committees within the community. Beryl volunteered for many years on charitable committees, most notably, for Meals on Wheels & St Vincent de Paul shop & is still an active member of the CWL (Catholic Women's League) & the St Finbars Fun Singers who sing monthly to the residents of the Buckland Nursing Home.
