#### FR JOE'S MUSINGS

Where From Here...

Last weekend Bishop Vincent and Fr. Jolly came to celebrate with us the Vigil Mass during which Bishop Vincent has installed me as PP of St Finbars. He said jokingly that my signature is very elaborate, like the one of the former US President Donald Trump. Of course, the US President has much more power and his decisions may have a great impact on billions of lives. Neither do I want power, nor do I think that I am here to govern. My understanding is that I am here to walk with you on your journey of faith. Together we walk as pilgrims of faith. On Being Together on the Journey, Vatican II states so wonderfully in one of its major documents: "The joys and the hopes, the griefs, and the anxieties of the people of this age, especially those who are poor or in any way afflicted, these are the joys and hopes, the griefs and anxieties of the followers of Christ. Indeed, nothing genuinely human fails to raise an echo in their hearts. For theirs is a community composed of people. United in Christ, they are led by the Holy Spirit in their journey to the Kingdom of their Father and they have welcomed the news of salvation which is meant for every person. That is why this community realizes that it is truly linked with mankind and its history by the deepest of bonds." (Gaudium et Spes no. 1)

I have said on many occasions that St Finbars is not MY parish. Rather, the parish is US and WE are the STEWARDS of the faith and its transmission to the next generation. Pope Francis calls us to be a new community, one that is SYNODAL. We are Church because we are BEING TOGETHER on the pilgrimage. This is an opportunity for conversion and renewal through a transformative gaze at the encounter with Jesus Christ. This Christ encounter enables us to realize that God desires and calls all people to holiness. Carried by this renewed self-awareness, we grow in confidence to take up responsibilities and to make our contributions to the building up of the Church. May I invite you to consider your involvement and to assist the Parish in building up a community that is transformative and faithful to Christ. There are many tasks in the House of the LORD.

Last weekend's celebration and welcoming hospitality have demonstrated visibly that we are BEING TOGETHER as a community. It has brought together old and young. The Columbarium was a common effort by many parishioners. To support the synodal way in our parish, we will soon resume the Plenary discussion process interrupted by COVID 19. I would like to thank you all for your commitment and love for God and for our Parish. I am so glad that I can be part of this wonderful community.

Next Wednesday is Ash Wednesday which marks the beginning of Lent. Lent is meant to be a time of repentance. That is not a feeling of shame, but an awareness that sin separates us from God and of what it cost Him to be reunited with us. That is why conflating Lent with New Year's resolutions is dangerous. This time of fasting should not add religious encouragement to a difficult goal: to lose weight, to stop watching pornography, or to give money to charity. "Lent is [...] an opportunity to contemplate what our Lord really did for us on the Cross." Resolutions reflect a desire for autonomy from God instead of recognizing that the body is the temple of the Holy Spirit (1 Corinthians 3:16, 6:19) and the work of the potter, to be regarded as precious (Isaiah 64:8).

Resolutions simply focus on "self," not Christ. Lent is a good time to give up one's own resolutions and listen for God's leading. Where God leads might be more difficult than any fast, and, here, Christians realize that they cannot do anything in their own strength either: only the grace of God is sufficient (2 Corinthians 12:9).
