FR JOE'S MUSINGS

Christ is TRULY RISEN

When I was in Germany, my friends from Greek Orthodox faith used to greet me at their celebration with these words: "Christos Anesti (Χριστός Ανέστη)". I then replied: "Alithos Anesti" (= "Truly, [Christ is] risen". It is not just an Easter salute, but also in its core a profession of faith because Christ is really risen from the death. Recent years are marked by the bushfires, the pandemic, and floods. The resurrection of Christ reminds us that there is someone who is not only resilient when facing disturbances of life but is also victorious over death.

2021 is my first Easter celebration at St Finbars. I am so grateful for this blessing. During the weeks leading to the celebration of Easter, I have observed many parishioners who worked tirelessly behind the scenes. To the members of the liturgy committee who have taken the lead in the preparations of the church for the festivities, the IT developers who have prepared the PowerPoints, the musicians who have spent hours in practising songs, the gardeners who have cleared the church's grounds from weeds and other unwelcome filth, the hospitality team who have taken care of the well-being of parishioners, the church cleaners and florists who have polished and decorated the church, the finance committee that has organised the sandstones for the columbarium to be completed before the Easter celebration, the young families and youth group who have taken responsibility for the stations of the cross and the veneration of the cross, the wardens who recorded details and welcomed parishioners, the altar servers who assisted the liturgical celebration, and finally the parish office staff who organised readers, servers etc. - I want to express my immense gratitude for your responsible leadership. Such commitment is rare, and I am very proud and privileged to have witnessed it. Your generous giving to our parish is unmatched!

Once the great Saint Augustine addressed his hearers with these words: And so it is with us. After our dark night of struggling, gladsome light radiates upon us from the splendour of God our Saviour. As the psalmist sang, "You changed my mourning into dancing, you removed my sackcloth and clothed me in gladness." (see Ps 20:12). So this is a day of mercy, a day of forgiveness and deliverance. The living throb with joy, and the dead experience ineffable relief. Boundless, free, rapturous and radiant, this day is like "a thousand years in the presence of God"

[Ps 84:4], for it is truly "the day God has made." Whoever perseveres in loving God his whole life long will merit the grace of delighting eternally in this day—this day on which the saints will sing songs of bliss, be flooded with every sort of splendor, and share in their Savior's joy as they proclaim and re-echo in chorus: "This is the day the Lord has made. Let us exult and thrill with joy!"


May I joint St Augustine in wishing you a very blessed and hope filled Feast of Christ's resurrection.

Yesterday, NSW Health wrote to us advising they have revised the COVID-19 guidelines for places of worship given the recently announced lockdown measures in Queensland. I trust that you are aware that there have now been several cases of community transmission detected in that state. The situation there increases the risk to your communities at this time, particularly vulnerable members of our parishes. Considering this, NSW Health has urged that we take the relevant precautions to protect our communities over this period. This includes requesting our parishioners who have been in the affected areas of Greater Brisbane since 20 March (Ipswich, Logan, Redlands, Moreton Bay and Brisbane Council Areas) to not attend religious services in person, in line with the current stay-at home requirements. Please also request that they consider their movements and whether they have been in any direct contact with people who may be visiting from those aforementioned areas during this period. Wearing of face masks at places of worship continues to be strongly recommended by NSW Health, especially indoors and when social distancing is not possible. Very Rev.
