FR JOE'S MUSINGS

Dear Friends,

I will be in Brisbane this week to attend a priestly ordination of young Augustinians. They have been in training for nearly ten years and are now ready to serve the people



of God. The ordination does not make them super beings. Rather, it obliges them to humble service in the name of Jesus Christ, the Saviour. While in QLD, I will also take some days off to reflect, to pray and to read and to relax so that I can serve you with renewed energy. I have not been able to take my annual leave since March 2020 when COVID 19 has reached our soil. I pray that the borders remain open! During my absence, Fr Bob Anderson, who is well known to our community, will graciously celebrate Masses and other liturgical

community, will graciously celebrate Masses and other liturgical services for us. He will stay in the presbytery. I am very sure that he will be very welcomed and looked after whilst being with us. On behalf of Saint Finbars, thank you Fr Bob for your generous assistance.

Today is the Sunday of Pentecost. Earlier Jesus had promised to send the Holy Spirit once he has returned to his heavenly Father. As you can imagine, the Holy Spirit is important for our Christian living. Holiness, therefore, has its deepest root in the grace of baptism, in being grafted on to the Paschal Mystery of Christ, by which his Spirit is communicated to us, his very life as the Risen One. St Paul strongly

communicated to us, his very life as the Risen One. St Paul strongly emphasizes the transformation that baptismal grace brings about in man and he reaches the point of coining a new terminology, forged with the preposition "with": *dead-with*, *buried-with*, *raised-with*, brought to *life-with*, with Christ; our destiny is indissolubly linked to his. "We were buried therefore with him by baptism" he writes, "into death, so that as Christ was raised from the dead ... we too might walk in newness of life" (Rom 6:4). Yet God always respects our freedom and asks that we accept this gift and live the requirements it entails and he asks that we let ourselves be transformed by the action of the Holy Spirit, conforming our will to the will of God.

We might ask ourselves: can we, with our limitations, with our weaknesses, aim so high? During the Liturgical Year, the Church invites us to commemorate a host of saints, the ones that is, who lived charity to the full, who knew how to love and follow Christ in their daily lives. They tell us that it is possible for everyone to take this road. In every epoch of the Church's history, on every latitude of the world map, the saints belong to all the ages and to every state of life, they are the actual faces of every people, language and nation. And they have very different characters.
