## FR JOE'S MUSINGS

## COVID 19 Vaccination: May you excel in this gracious act also...

Finally, on Wednesday I got my first dose of the Pfizer vaccine. The second will be a month later. I got the Pfizer vaccine because I belong to the category under 50! Juliana and Peter have already been vaccinated against Covid. I am aware that among Catholic ethicists and moral theologians there is debate about vaccination. Of course, I am conscious of the *pro* and *contra* arguments. From the Catholic point of view, as Pope Francis has suggested earlier in an interview, COVID 19 vaccination may to be considered as a *moral obligation*. He said:

'I believe that morally everyone must take the vaccine. It is the moral choice because it is about your life but also the lives of others.' *The Congregation of the Doctrine of the Faith* also affirms that it is 'morally acceptable for Catholics to take vaccines against the Coronavirus.' In a statement, the Congregation said: 'When ethically irreproachable COVID -19 vaccines are not available ... it is morally acceptable to receive COVID-19 vaccines that have used cell lines from aborted foetuses in their research and production process. In the absence of other means to stop or even prevent the epidemic, the common good may recommend vaccination, especially to protect the weakest and most exposed.'

In today's second reading, St. Paul asked that Christians not only excel in skills and knowledge, but more in gracious acts. According to a dictionary, gracious acts are voluntary acts that may include kindness, gratitude, and empathy. Yet, the bible associates the gracious act first and foremost with God who is gracious and compassionate, slow to anger and rich in love. The Lord is good to all; he has compassion on all he has made." (Psalm 145:8-9). It has to do with God's generosity by which he redeemed us. This attribute of God, his graciousness, the consistent favour he shows towards humanity, is something the Bible celebrates. It is presented throughout Scripture as the undeserved gift it truly is.

Hence, St Paul emphasised the value of grace: 'Let your speech always be gracious.' (Colossians 4:6). This means that Christians are not to propagate things that go against God's compassionate and loving nature. It would be taking God's name in vain!

Of course, we need to speak out against inaccuracies and deception. Not only is it gracious to humbly inform people of their error, and protect others from it, but how we talk can be gracious or ungracious.

What does Paul celebrate first about love in 1 Corinthians 13? "Love is patient" (1 Corinthians 13:4). He considered patience to be one of the distinguishing marks of his ministry (2 Corinthians 6:6; 12:12; 2 Timothy 3:10). "Be patient" is one of his repeated exhortations to church leaders (1 Thessalonians 5:14; 2 Timothy 2:24; 4:2). And not just patience, but as 2 Timothy 4:2 commends, "complete patience"!

Paul prays that we would be "strengthened with all power, according to his glorious might, for all endurance and patience with joy" (Colossians 1:11). This is the kind of patience we need. We can grit our teeth and endure without joy and win no one. Or we can endure with contagious joy, and out-rejoice those who don't yet see things as we think they should.

God is graciously generous towards us. Shouldn't we also be generous and compassionate towards ourselves and others? If God always cares for our common good, are we not also to act in the interest of the common good? Have a great Sunday.

## RE: COVID-19 (CORONAVIRUS) UPDATE

NSW Health has revised the COVID-19 guidelines.

The following are effective Wednesday 23 June 2021, and applicable for seven days across Greater Sydney and the Blue Mountains.

Places of Worship and Religious Services The maximum number of people at places of worship will now be limited by the 4 square metre rule (rather than 2 square metres), both indoors and outdoors.

Weddings and Funerals The maximum number of people at weddings and funerals will also be limited by the 4 square metre rule (rather than 2 square metres), both indoors and outdoors.

<u>Singing Indoor</u> singing by the congregation is not permitted at this time. No information has been provided by NSW Health on choirs at this time. Further information will be communicated when this becomes available.

**Face Masks** NSW Health continues to mandate that masks are to be worn at all indoor venues, including places of worship.

## <u>CANCELLED - LITURGICAL – SPIRITUAL FORMATION DAY.</u>


Please note that the Spiritual Formation Day has been cancelled due to the new Covid-19 Restrictions.
