### FR JOE'S MUSINGS

Dear Friends,

We have just completed the first week of the two weeks lockdown. It is not easy when the lockdown or restrictions were announced repeatedly about the time of holidays or school vacation. This is supposed to be a time to relax and to energize and to travel. I know some parishioners whose travel plans have been shattered through the closure of borders. It is not just the financial, but the emotional cost that is probably counting. For children and for parents, the lockdown must be hard. For the elderly who once again are isolated in their homes and aged care, it is devastating. Humans are emotional beings too!

We ask ourselves: When will it all end? Not so soon, for sure. Unless most of us are vaccinated there will be continuous disruption and separation. We have to cancel Masses and Baptisms last weekend and during the week. I am aware that last year, some parishioners could not celebrate even a funeral Mass for their loved ones who had passed away because of COVID.

What I have learnt during this time of uncertainty is that Australians are quite resilient. In bad times, we reach out and the mentality of "mateship" is put to best practice. So, let us also maintain this wonderful Australian character and quality.

If you know someone in your neighbourhood who is alone or elderly or needs help, please do not hesitate to reach with your hands and heart. In this time of challenge, let us shine forth as the faces of Jesus Christ.

COVID has taken us out of our daily routine. We are looking to have normality back. To keep our sense of normality, we will live-stream the weekend Vigil Mass at 5.30pm. It will be uploaded on YouTube and made available for you to follow at your usual time when you would attend the Mass. If you are a 5.30pm person, then invite your family to the Mass on YouTube. If you are a 7.30am or 9.30am, then do the same at your normal Mass time. At least it will give us a little sense of normality. I know that it is not the reality. However, through keeping our sense of normality we intend to fight back the disruption that COVID has caused in our lives! By the way, this manner of worship reminds us of the early Church when people gathered at homes to read and share the Word of God and Communion. Let us make our homes to become the Cradle of our Faith once again!

If you wish, just skip my homily, and share with each other your reflection about the readings of Sunday. If you wish, just post it on our parish Facebook or other media platforms so all can read and reflect upon. This is one way in which we share spiritual communion.

Thanks to Ryan and Pat who have explored and organised for us the YouTube and online streaming.

If you experience distress while staying at home, please ask for help. I am also here for you!

St Paul wrote to the Corinthians these words: "We all experience times of testing, which is normal for every human being. But God will be faithful to you. He will screen and filter the severity, nature, and timing of every test or trial you face so that you can bear it. And each test is an opportunity to trust him more, for along with every trial God has provided for you a way of escape that will bring you out of it victoriously."

#### COVID UPDATE FROM PARRAMATTA DIOCESE

Dear Brothers & Sisters in Christ,

NSW Health has issued new Covid-19 guidelines for indoor venues, including places of worship. These guidelines are effective from 26 June 2021, until midnight Friday 9 July 2021. The following rule changes will continue to apply until that date.

#### Places of Worship and Religious Services

Public Masses, based on the directive of the NSW government (both indoor and outdoor) must cease. Also effected by this closure are church buildings, adoration chapels and other church buildings used for prayer and religious services.

#### **Funerals**

Funerals are still permitted with a maximum number of 100 attendees. If the funeral takes place in a church building the social distancing rules must be observed and will be limited by the 4 square metre rule. During this period. It is recommended that a simple grave side service be held or using the crematorium chapel with a small number of mourners (very immediate family) only. A memorial Mass when the current crisis is declared over can be held later. NSW Health continues to mandate that face masks are to be worn at all indoor venues, including places of worship.
