With COVID-19 still very much present in the community, we welcome your

continued use of masks while attending Mass, your continued use of QR codes or the written sheet to check in and check out, and your observance of social distancing where possible to try and keep all of us safe from the pandemic.

Today we celebrate the fact the Jesus, both God and man, chose to be Baptised. By this act the Son of God is identifying with the community of all humanity, with each one of us, and with our ultimate destiny of salvation. Jesus came to John the Baptist who baptised the Lord and submitted to His authority. John identified Jesus as "the Lamb of God, who takes away the sins of the world" (John 1:29).

The feast of the Baptism of the Lord is an opportunity for all of us to reflect on our own Baptism. For many of us it happened a long time ago, but it was the beginning of our continuing lifelong pilgrimage here on earth to become worthy to see the face of God in Heaven. The graces we receive from this Sacrament help us to grow into an active member of the Body of Christ.

Our Baptism needs to be a community experience. By this I mean that we need to join our fellow parishioners in being actively involved in the life of the church. We do not want to just drift along as passive members of our community, expecting the church to do everything for us. We need to decide what we can do for the church and use our time and talents to further the goals of the parish community. We might even ask ourselves if we have confirmed the Baptismal commitment that our Godparents made on our behalf at our Baptism?

Here is a thought that we might ponder on during the coming week: As baptised sisters and brothers of Christ, we are all the beloved daughters and sons of God. Do we really believe this? If not, what are the obstacles preventing us from doing so?

Finally, let us offer a prayer that both Fr Joe and Deacon Andrew both have a relaxing holiday and come back to us ready to take on 2022 and whatever it might bring into Glenbrook community.
