FR JOE'S MUSINGS

The Year of the Tiger...

If you were born in 2022, 2010, 1998, 1986, 1974, 1962, 1950, 1938, then it is supposed to be your YEAR, the year of the Tiger. The Tiger is known as the king of all beasts in Southeast Asia. The zodiac sign Tiger is a symbol of strength, exorcising evils, and braveness. As part of the Lunar celebration, many Asian kids wear hats or shoes with a tiger image for good luck. So, congratulations to those who were born in the Year of the Tiger.

This Sunday's gospel of Luke heralds, however, a new and good beginning for those who live in faith for the sake of Christ and the world. Hence, Luke urged his readers that the good news of gratuitous salvation had to be brought into the world. People's salvation depended on hearing the message. How would one go about evangelizing the world?

I am convinced that all our Parish groups heed these words of Luke. Jesus chose twelve "disciples" and sent them to the poor, the hungry and the persecuted. Is it possible to evangelize the world in this way? Yes, in no other way!

The good news for our Parish is that Martin Rogers and Jesse Mowbray at the first PPC meeting in 2022 have been elected as Chair and Deputy of the Parish Pastoral Council for the period of one year. Please join me in thanksgiving to God for the talents and gifts that both will bring to ou Parish. During this PPC meeting, Melissa McDonald and Martin Roger were welcomed as ordinary members. Since last year, we have inducted a new model of PPC nomination and election. Parishioners nominate parishioners and an Election Committee of three members (Coller Fuller, Vince Dobson and Julian Khnouf) make recommendation to the Parish Priest who formally appoints the new members. We will reasses this model at a later stage to see whether it works for the benefit of ou Parish. Furthermore, at the same meeting we also have discussed a new structure for PPC. Members of the PPC will now coordinate a particula "portfolio", such as Evangelization, Parish Social Wellbeing and Welfare, Social Justice and Ecology, Property and Maintenance Education and Formation etc. These "portfolios" will be given an annua budget (under the direction of the Parish Finance Committee) that will cover activities done on behalf of our Parish.

Also, Martin Rogers reported on the outcome of the Parish Plenary. I seems that two complementary themes emerge from this process:

1) Community building and 2) Strong Parish Faith Formation. The PPC will explore ways to implement these themes.

In the meantime, a Parish Formation Calendar for 2022 has been completed. May I invite you to have a look at the calendar and reserve the dates in your diary. The first formation event will take place on 19 February on the topic "The Mass: We go every Sunday, but we don't get it". The day will be led by Fr Peter Williams AM, Vicar General of the Diocese and Lecturer in Liturgy at the Catholic Institute of Sydney.

I also would like to invite you to our first Parish Annual Gathering on 27/2 after the 9.30am Sunday Mass. This gathering will give us an opportunity to appreciate the missionary works that our Parish groups are undertaking on behalf of our Parish and to discuss and share the hope and future direction of Parish.
