FR JOE'S MUSINGS

I say to you "Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you". These words from today's Gospel appear very difficult and seem to express an idealism that may feel impossible for most of us to live out in practice. To love our enemies is so contrary to human nature. How can anyone live like that?

I think one of the key messages in today's Gospel is that we are being called to a new way of living, of behaving and of responding to our daily human encounters. We are being told that our response to those who wrong us will not just depend on ourselves alone, but on grace that comes from God.

It seems to me that this Gospel passage also contains the recipe for how we can put Christ's teaching into practice: "Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful. Do not judge and you will not be judged, do not condemn and you will not be condemned, forgive and you will be forgiven".

It turns out that the severity of God's judgement of each of us depends on how we judge others! Jesus invites us to respond to the world as He did – by loving, blessing, and praying. The golden rule is often expressed as do unto others as we would have them do unto us.

In Australia, we often see the word "love" as a hurdle. To us it is an emotional word implying affection and intimacy. But Jesus is not telling us to be in love with our enemies, or even to like them. The type of love Jesus is referring to is known by the Greek word "agape". It can be translated as an attitude of positive regard towards others by which we wish for their well-being. This is in fact the love that God has for us that continues unabated no matter whether we return that love or not.

To love as God loves is to focus more on other people than on ourselves. Be a channel for God's love to others, not just those we like but also to those whom we might think of as our enemies.

During this week, we might ask for God's grace to help us love others rather than judge them. Remember that, when it comes to judgement, what you give is what you get!


