FR JOE'S MUSINGS

Dear Friends,

The Gospel of this Sunday retells the Transfiguration of the Lord. Interestingly, Luke also relates to the Transfiguration the Old Testament experience of Exodus since Jesus pointed to the passion (*exodus*) through which the glory is achieved. Having been enslaved for over hundreds of years, Yahweh finally came to rescue Israel from slavery. To remember this liberating event, Jesus and his disciples celebrated the Passover. Jesus would not want to take shortcuts since we all experience our own "exodus" (sufferings). In his Transfiguration, Jesus does not forget our wounds and the hurts and rejections we experience. Hence, the truth is true when it says that through Jesus' passion our lives have been transformed.

A sort of transformation was last Sunday's Lent *SouperBowl* with St Andrew's Uniting church, the Baptist church, and our own St Finbar's. Over 150 parishioners gathered all together in our Parish Hall to share one or two bowls of delicious soups prepared by our generous chefs. We were also happy to be able to welcome Cr Brendan Christie, who represented the BMCC as Deputy Mayor. The table fellowship was enriched and enliven by personal encounters and conversations.

Besides the ecumenical friendship, the Sunday raised *1,000* AUD that will go our local charity "Gateway – Families Services" in Blaxland, a charity that was recommend to us by Cr Mark Greenhill, Mayor of the BMC. This is an example of both ecumenism and cooperation with civic organizations that is rarely heard about elsewhere in the Diocese. It must have been the work of the Holy Spirit.

I would like to express my deepest gratitude to our volunteers who prepared an abundance of wonderful soups that probably could feed 5000. Thanks also for all the help with serving and cleaning.

Our next *SouperBowl* will be held on 20 March 2022 at 11.30 at our neighbouring Baptist church. Once again, the proceeds will go towards *Gateway* – Families service. Perhaps, this time St Finbar's can do better as there were not many from our Parish attending our Lent Soup Fasting Sunday (except the big number of volunteers). This is a good occasion not just to exercise Lent, but also to do so with our Christian sisters and brothers. This a good way to publicly demonstrate the goodness of our Christian faith to broader community. It is a way to live our missionary calling.

There will be a list in the Narthex for you to register your name for the next *SouperBowl* Sunday at 11.30 am on 20 March 2022. We may meet at our church around 11.20 am and walk together to our Baptist neighbour. Another event of *Faith Formation 2022* commenced last Tuesday 8 March. Fr Joe presented a talk on the **Passion of Jesus in the Gospel of Luke**. He pointed out that Jesus' Passion precisely describes the authentic discipleship that we are called to. As God is the faithful God, we are called to trust Him. Jesus's struggle can become our fight for justice and reconciliation, a fight that can be won also through the force of prayers. Sr Dr Margaret Ghosn will present the next talk on the "Death of Jesus in the Gospel of Luke" on **Tuesday 28 March from 7-8.30pm**. Come and learn from the Gospel about the love and sufferings of Jesus.
