Greetings to all fellow parishioners.

It is with a humble heart that I begin this introduction by thanking each of you, the parishioners of St Finbar's Parish, for making it possible for me to serve as a member of the Parish Pastoral Council.

Wow! Just reading this title even leaves me feeling nervous and humbled, all at the same time.

With the reality of such a large family, poverty was a integral part of my childhood. We lived a simple life in a small country town with a population of about 1100 people, in rural NSW.

I attended the local Catholic Primary School, St Joseph's and my year 6 teacher Sr Brendan, left a lasting impact on my life journey. Somehow she was able to reflect for me my goodness and the possibility of being more than I was able to dream. She became my advocate in a pathway of possibilities and set me on a trajectory to tertiary education-something totally foreign to my family.

I attended the local secular High School and was the only girl to complete Year 11 and 12. Fortunately another girl came from Brewarrina to complete her final two years while living with her grandparents. In total this was a class of eight. I attended a Catholic University. Currently I continue to serve as a teacher in a Diocesan Primary School. From my place of knowing, my commitment and contribution to Catholic Education has been significant as a life focus.

## PRE-PRINTED ENVELOPES REPLACED BY REGULAR ONLINE PAYMENTS

Further to the item in the last Barra, the parish will be discontinuing the use of pre-printed envelopes for the second collection as at 30<sup>th</sup> June 2022.

The parish's preferred option is that you establish an online payment plan before 1<sup>st</sup> July 2022. This is very easy to do. You do not need a computer or a smart phone or any special skills, and if you are in any doubt about what to do, please contact me after Mass or in the parish office and I will guide you through the process.

There are two ways to make regular online payments happen automatically without you having to remember to do anything:

- The first option is to authorise the parish to make a regular monthly (or weekly) deduction from you nominated bank account. To do this you just need to complete the Direct Debit form available on the parish website under the Mass & Sacraments heading (<u>https://stfinbars.org.au/</u><u>#masstimes</u>) and either email it to me (<u>admin@stfinbars.org.au</u>) or give it to Fr Joe or drop it into the parish office. If this is a problem, you can collect a paper copy of this form from the Wardens' Table. You can change the amount you give anytime you want to, or terminate the payment anytime.
- The second option is to authorise the parish to make a regular monthly (or weekly) deduction from your nominated credit card. To do this you just need to complete the Credit Card form which is also available on the parish website under the same Mass & Sacraments heading (<u>https://stfinbars.org.au/#masstimes</u>) and either email it to me(<u>admin@stfinbars.org.au</u>) or give it to Fr Joe or drop it in to the parish office. If this is a problem, you can collect a paper copy of this form from the Wardens' Table. You can change the amount you give anytime you want to, or terminate the payment anytime.

There are other options (less desirable from the parish's point of view) that you can use, but they require you to remember to make the payments on a regular basis:

- a. Make a payment using the Make a Payment button at the top of the front page of the parish website if you do this please scroll down and select the Biller Code 1001887
- b. Place cash in a plain envelope (which the parish will supply) and place the envelope in the second collection.
- C. Place loose cash directly into the second collection.

The parish thanks you for your generous contributions to date and hopes you will embrace this change to secure the future of the parish.
