

(It hard to mention these ministries without saying – 'Come join us'... so I hope that's ok!?)

I grew up on the North Shore and my first parish was Our Lady of Perpetual Succour in West Pymble and then my mum and siblings attended Sacred Heart, Pymble through my teen years and early 20s. We lived near bushland which was our playground as kids – we had a lot more freedom, for better or worse. I love the bush and am happy to be living so close to it again, now in Blaxland. I was blessed to develop strong friendships at my Pymble parish with likeminded young Catholics in the Antioch group and when we were too old and a bit over that format, we formed our own group called Patmos. It was a space where we could learn, question and grow in the faith together. I remember the PP at Sacred Heart would groan when he'd see a friend and I approach him as he knew we came with questions! But for me a faith which does not ask questions is not growing – I love when my Scripture students have questions. It tells me they are thinking.

I have found the Plenary process inspiring so far. I am not sure it will achieve all that I'd like to see change in the Church but it already has achieved much in bringing people together to think and dream about how things in the Church could be better. People may have differing dreams for the Church but the Holy Spirit can bring forth the harmony amongst the voices. Just being able to listen to the voice of God in one another is an end in itself too. Sometimes I have felt disconnected from Church and parish life but the Eucharist and the Scriptures always sustain me – where else can we go for the 'words of eternal life'.

I feel blessed to be a part of this community of people of God. I hope we can continue to inspire each other as fellow sojourners. I am grateful to Fr Joe for the opportunity to part of the PPC (with my 'L' plates on) and I hope I can make a contribution to my portfolio areas of Ecology and Social justice which are so very important to our faith life.
