FR JOE'S MUSINGS

Dear Friends.

Greetings from Germany. Europe is experiencing a heatwave never seen before. Even the POMS and the Celts are now having a really hot "SUMMER" Not just climatic trouble, but there are talks also about an economic "tsunami". My little sister who lives in Munich has saved for a year, but the inflation has shattered her dream of having her own place. She shares the same experience with many Aussies!

The persisting drought has made bananas, greens and bread luxury items for many families. According to a recent statistic, Germans only shower every third day to save energy and water cost and surcharge. The European Union is now planning to curb the rise of energy consumption by rationing energy to private households. The gigantic rise of petrol price (a litre costs 2.80 AUD) has transformed Germany into a new Netherlands. The sale of bicycles exceeds the number of car sales. Germans are now pedal horse riders!

The airlines are struggling to take off with their union members calling on strike daily. As a traveller, I have already lost more than 1200 AUD on airfares. Rebooking a ticket does not automatically qualify to fly. It all depends on the strike.

Russian conflict continues to dominate the screens. The Russian bombs on Odessa (a port of Ukraine) prevent the export the millions of tons of grain, effectively putting more than 247 million people in the sub-Saharan region at risk of starvation.

Adding to the nightmare, I also have contracted the European variant of omicron and have been in isolation. Instead of joining my family for excursions and parties, I am writing this column in my room with a cup of lemon hot tea and *tasteless* food!

I want to celebrate Mass for my deceased Mum and visit her


I want to celebrate Mass for my deceased Mum and visit her grave...but isolation.

Yet as I read the bible everyday and pray, I realise that a crisis is a good time for faith discernment, one that can bring new hope and deliberation.

Tomorrow's unknown crisis is not something to avoid in fear. It requires our attention and deliberation. We need to have the courage to face the truth of our uncertainty.

PAPAL INVITATION TO WYD PILGRIMAGE 2023

Dear friends.

Pope Francis once again invites the young Church to join him at the 16th International World Youth Day in Lisbon, Portugal next August 2023. It is the third chapter in his Marian journey and features the theme; "Mary arose and went with haste" (LK 1:39) There is no doubt that this enriching experience of pilgrimage for young people has a profound impact on their relationship with Jesus, their prayer life, their lived mission and their relationships with others.

I am continually inspired by the witness of faith and vocation in our past pilgrims - many of whom I regularly see in my own journey around the Diocese. In this post-pandemic world, I see a great need for bringing young people intentionally together in formation and community towards this mountain-top experience knowing that its fruits are years in the making, well beyond a return to their school, parish, professional and personal lives.

The Diocese of Parramatta will lead one pilgrimage to Portugal. I have appointed James Camden, Head Mission Engagement (Chancery) and Mark Smith, Head Mission (CEDP) as joint Pilgrimage Co-ordinators to lead our team. Our encounter with Jesus, Mary and the Saints begins in France, travelling through Spain and onto Portugal before a time of retreat in Assisi, Italy. Our pilgrimage will total 22 days between 21 July - 11 August.

I encourage each parish and school community over the coming month to consider how they might identify and support two to three young pilgrims attending WYD23. All fundraising will be the responsibility of each pilgrim in lieu of a Diocesan raffle. Potential pilgrims, including clergy, aspiring group leaders and those interested in this significant youth engagement strategy are invited to attend the launch event with the team and I on Thursday 18 August from 7pm at St John XXIII Catholic College, Stanhope Gardens. I pray that our young people, and those that accompany them on this journey, will be transformed by the lives of St Vincent de Paul, St Thérèse of Lisieux, Our Lady of Lourdes, St Ignatius of Loyola, St Teresa of Ávila, Our Lady of Fátima, St Francis of Assisi and St Clare over our 12 month pilgrimage.
