FR JOE'S MUSINGS

The last I heard from Fr Joe was that his COVID isolation period had ended and that he was out and about, making up for time lost due to the disease. He has sent some pictures from his travels, including of the Archdiocese of Bamburg and some of its treasures, the tomb of Emperor St Henry and his wife, and one of a Venice-like canal in Germany. Let us pray that he is fully recovered and that he enjoys the rest of his holidays.

Earlier this week the last of the 2022 Sacramental programs got underway. You might remember that our eligible children made their first Reconciliation back in May, and those who were ready received their first Holy Communion last month.

Now it is time for the sacrament of Confirmation, and the first of the preparation sessions began on the Thursday just gone. There were about 30 children, together with their parents, who started learning what this sacrament is all about.

The sacrament of Confirmation binds the baptized Christians more perfectly to the church and enriches them with the gifts of the Holy Spirit, namely Wisdom, Understanding, Counsel, Fortitude, Knowledge, Piety and Fear of the Lord.

We can all take part in this preparation by making a point of praying for these children over the next five weeks, asking the Holy Spirit to come into their hearts and strengthen the faith that God has given to each of them.

Our readings at Mass today remind us yet again to be watchful and ready for the inevitable call of the Lord. We need to make sure we are awake and ready when the master comes. We need to ask for his help not to live a distracted life, so that when Jesus comes into our life, in a way and at a time we do not expect, He finds mus ready to welcome him.

One way to do this is to take time to look at your day. You can look at your day so far, or look at yesterday, and see how aware you have been of God in your life. You can ask for the grace not to be deaf to his call. You can do a good examination of your conscience to see what more you can do to keep Christ and his interests at the top of your priorities in this earthly life. In that way you will be ready to enjoy the heavenly life when your invitation comes.
