**FR JOE'S MUSINGS**

**Ordinary Time? Bored?**

Liturgically, the Christmas season concludes with the solemnity of Jesus' Baptism on 7<sup>th</sup> January. It follows the so-called *Ordinary Time*. Because the term ordinary in English most often means something that's not special or distinctive, many people think that Ordinary Time refers to parts of the calendar of the Catholic Church that are unimportant. Even though the season of Ordinary Time makes up most of the liturgical year in the Catholic Church, the fact that Ordinary Time refers to those periods that fall outside of the major liturgical seasons reinforces this impression. Yet Ordinary Time is far from unimportant or uninteresting. The Latin word *ordinalis*, which refers to numbers in a series, stems from the Latin word *ordo*, from which we get the English word *order*. Thus, the numbered weeks of Ordinary Time, in fact, represent the *ordered life of the Church*—the period in which we live our lives neither in feasting (as in the Christmas and Easter seasons) nor in more severe penance (as in Advent and Lent), but in watchfulness and expectation of the Second Coming of Christ. That is the reason that the gospel of the second Sunday (14<sup>th</sup> January) after the Baptism of Jesus begins with an invitation to follow Jesus: "The next day Jesus decided to go to Galilee. He found Philip and said to him, "Follow me." Hence, Ordinary Time is a time **for growth and maturation**, a time in which the mystery of Christ is called to penetrate ever more deeply into history until all things are finally caught up in Christ. The goal, toward which all of history is directed, is represented by the final Sunday in Ordinary Time, the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe.

Our Parish formation calendar may assist us in our continuous growth and maturation of the faith. **Mr Chris Ohlsen**, who was the first lay executive assistant to Bishop Vincent and recipient of ACU Centre for Liturgy Postgraduate Scholarship, is an expert in liturgical formation of adults. He will talk about the sacrament of the Eucharist on two nights (Wednesdays 21 Feb and 28 Feb 2024, at 7.30pm in the church). Fr Joseph Lam will present three lectures on the Passion, Death and Resurrection of Jesus in the gospel of Mark since the readings of 2024 will be taken from this gospel (Tue 5<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup> March, at 7.30pm). To conclude our faith formation activities for Lent, our traditional Passover meal will be celebrated in the Parish Hall (Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> March at 7.30pm). We are currently organising with our ecumenical friends the traditional Lenten Soup Sundays. For both events, we need your assistance and help.
