# **Sunday of Divine Mercy**

Divine Mercy Sunday is celebrated on the Second Sunday of Easter. It is based on the private revelations of St. Faustina Kowalska, which recommended a particular devotion to the Divine Mercy.

To ensure that the faithful would observe this day with intense devotion, Pope John Paul II himself established that this Sunday be enriched by a plenary indulgence, as will be explained below, so that the faithful might receive in great abundance the gift of the consolation of the Holy Spirit.

Pope Francis reflects on the divine mercy: "Not only do the disciples receive mercy; they become dispensers of the mercy that they themselves received. They receive this power not on account of their merits or studies, but as a pure gift of grace, based however on their experience of having been themselves forgiven."

St Nicholas of Myra parish in Penrith invites you to celebrate the Sunday of Divine Mercy on 7<sup>th</sup> April starting at 2:30pm.

At St Finbar's I give thanks to God and to our many faithful and committed parishioners who have given up their precious time to prepare and to organise the liturgies of the Holy Week and Easter. We may not yet have our Resurrection bodies, but we already have within us the Resurrection life of Jesus. The time is past when "we were by nature deserving of wrath". Now we are alive and seated with Christ in the heavenly realms. We must not forget that, but live according to that truth.
