FR JOE'S MUSINGS

"I can image no greater heroism than Motherhood."

This Sunday many Australians will spend the day celebrating their mothers and other special women in their lives. Some mums may be given cards, flowers and gifts, while others may enjoy breakfast in bed or a lunch out.

Stories of a mother's love will fill annals in God's library of unrecognized faithfulness, even though true motherhood is more broad than just that.

Mother's Day is a good opportunity to once again talk about God's motherly qualities. God has Mother's Day too!

In Hebrew, the mercy of God is profoundly feminine. The mercy of God is God's motherly side. We know this beautiful passage from the book of the prophet Isaiah: "As a mother comforts, so I will comfort you." (Isaiah 66:13) We also know the image of the comforting, breastfeeding mother from Psalm 131:2: "As a breastfed child with it's mother, like the breast-fed child, so is my soul in me." In God's motherly love children feel secure.

Motherhood is woven into the very fabric of creation, and God says that all of creation tells about his glory (Psalms 19:1; Romans 1:20).

Women, like God, have the gift of generative love. A woman has the ability to love a man in such a way that she can turn him into a human being. Indeed, women are the type of people whom other people come out of. Mothers have a kind of incarnational power.

They incarnate marital love in a human person. Also, motherhood reflects the nurturing nature of God. Without mothers, we would be naked, hungry, and afraid. So mothers are a visual picture of God's tangible care for us.

Mothers are a gift to all humanity because they show us what God is like. In a loving mother we see Christ, who longs to gather his people like a mother hen would gather her chicks under her wings (Mathew 23:37).

Motherhood is not a hobby; it is a calling. Mothers don't collect children because they think children are cuter than stamps. Or because mothers can just squeeze their children somehow between their jobs and hobbies.


