It is precisely on this point that the Church of our age has much to re-learn.

In the name of synodality, there really is a lot of activity in the Church today. In the name of synodality, there is a kind of busyness that stretches people to the limits of their strength, and often beyond. But what is mostly missing now is that silent abiding before the Word of God, loosening the grasp of our will and actions. To be sure, the Lord does require our hard work and our dedication. But we require His presence. We need to rediscover the courage to leave things undone, and thus the humility of waiting before the Word. Very often, a single hour spent listening to God's Word in silence would do us more good than whole conferences filled with "Think Tank" meetings and discussions, and one moment of prayer would bear more fruit than whole stacks of planning documents.

But when it comes to affecting the world around us, what we do is by no means more important than what *we are* when we become mature and free and true by placing the roots of our being in the fruitful silence of God.
