#### A REFLECTION ON TODAY'S READINGS

The readings for today guide us in understanding faith, suffering, and discipleship. They teach us to listen to God's word, to act on our faith, and to follow Jesus' path. Reflecting on these themes helps us grow closer to God and strengthens our commitment to our faith.

## Listening to God

In the first reading Isaiah speaks about the servant who listens to God and does not turn away. This shows us the importance of being attentive to God's voice in our lives. We are called to be open and willing to hear what God has to say to us.

Listening to God means being present, being still and paying attention to God's guidance. It involves setting aside time for prayer and reflection. By doing this, we can better understand God's will for us and how we should live.

#### Faith and Works

James teaches us in the second reading that faith without works is dead. Believing in God is important, but we also need to show our faith through our actions, particularly by helping those in need.

Helping others and living out our faith go hand in hand. When we help those in need, we show the love of God in action. Our faith becomes alive and active through our good works. Here we are called to examine our lives. Are our actions reflecting our faith? Are we living in a way that shows our commitment to God?

#### **Following Jesus**

In the Gospel Jesus asks His disciples who they think He is. Peter responds, "You are the Christ." But following Christ means accepting His path, even when it is difficult.

Jesus calls us to take up our cross and follow Him. This means we may face challenges and hardships as part of our faith journey. We may have to give up our own desires and face many difficulties, but by doing so, we find true life in Christ.

Lord, help us to listen to Your voice and follow Your path. Give us the strength to live out our faith through our actions. May we take up our cross and find true life in You. Amen.
