FATHER JOHN PONDERS	PARISH INFORMATION
I have often pondered the unique position we have as Christians alongside our fallen nature. How do we make sense of it? The exquisite nature of our creation, made in the image and likeness of God. Now a fallen species with the likeness very much not looking like the image of God. How do we make our way in the world bearing the consequences of the Fall from Grace (what St. Augustine described as the Original Sin). We are weighed down with imperfection even as we strive to do our best from time to time. We easily get frustrated with what life throws at us, or become despondent because of our own shortcomings. In the midst of our ponderings about ourselves and our lives and the sense we are to make of them, I believe we need to get things in perspective. Certainly, our main task on earth is to get to heaven with the help of God's grace. Yes, it can be an uphill struggle and we cannot afford to lose sight of our heavenly goal. Obviously it is good to have a solid foundation about who we truly are in order to be consoled about what God thinks about each of us so that we feel positive about the steps we take in moving in the right direction.
