"The purpose of life is to find your gift, the meaning of life is to give it away". (unknown)

To describe life as an adventure certainly makes sense when we are having the time of our lives. For example, visiting places overseas can give us an expanded experience of the world, its beauty and the many opportunities for discovery. There is so much to see and to do. Even locally, to go to the western end of the Blue Mountains will give a very different vista than to slip along the Great Western Highway and face east over Metropolitan Sydney and, on a clear day, even see the Harbour Bridge. Heading for Europe gives us access to a long social and political history of long-ago times. The opportunities are almost endless.

When we are somewhat down in the dumps we tend to have a very different experience of life. We feel hemmed in. We can only focus on how we are being negatively affected by life. We don't like it and we don't seem to have the energy or reason to get excited. But life goes on and we know that we can't stand still because the world will keep spinning and bring us with it.

Most of the time we find ourselves plonked right in the middle of these two contrasting experiences and cope with life by accepting what comes along and dealing with it to the best of our abilities. As we advance in years we gain wisdom. The uncertainty we experience in early years is replaced by a deeper appreciation of who we are and what we can do. This is the wonderful path in growing in "self-regard". This positive experience enables us to acknowledge with gratitude the gifts we have accumulated throughout life whatever the circumstances whether positive or negative. The positive extends our opportunities, the seeming negative experience endows us with fortitude in the midst of adversity. We find ourselves enfolded in an experience of utter joys as we "count our blessings".

At some point we might feel so overwhelmed with our giftedness that we believe that we have more than our fair share of God's blessings and that it is about time we began to shower these blessings around town. Ah, is this the wisdom of elderly people who have lived life with all its ups and downs and who have survived and know so much? Well, it is certainly one form of acquired insights which can be of great benefit to be shared around.

I know I keep banging on about the importance of finding meaning and purpose in life. It encapsulates stability and gives direction and flourishing to how we live our lives to the full. For the followers of Christ this does not mean hording up meaning and purpose for ourselves, it means giving away the gifts we have accumulated which bring us that inner peace so that others may also share in how we flourish in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.
