Father John ponders......

"Christianity is the meeting-point of earth and heaven," it opens by saying. "It lays claim to the whole man, body and soul, intellect and will, inducing him to raise his mind above the changing conditions of this earthly existence and reach upwards for the eternal life of heaven, where one day he will find his unfailing happiness and peace."

(From Mater et Magistra, John XXIII)

If one thing can be said about Pope John XXIII it is that he always had his feet placed firmly on the ground. He was the smiling pope who knew what it was to walk around the streets, smelling the sheep long before Pope Francis. His decisive decision to initiate Vatican Council II was a clear indication that his love for Christ's church was that it too should have its boots firmly on the ground. It meant change, and we are still living out his dream. Yet, for all John XXIII's down-to-earth application of the Catholic faith we can ascertain from our quotation today that it was very much dependant on a more subtle appreciation of the spiritual nature of humanity and the Church.

Mater et Magistra means Mother and Teacher and is Pope John's encyclical teaching about the nature of the Catholic Church Her role as mother is the sacramental one, giving new birth to those who are baptised. She also has a role in teaching the baptised about the true nature of Christ the Redeemer, and the true nature of ourselves as those who are now children of God. The inheritance which belongs to Christ from the Almighty Father, now belongs to us because Christ shares with us everything that he has. This is quite an outstanding truth and is a guiding light by which we can make our way on earth to eventually arrive at our heavenly inheritance, eternal life.

"Boots on the ground" is our way of living out our vocations, but Pope John also encourages us to live out our lives not only with a view to heaven, but with the realisation that we already participate in heavenly realities, for Christianity is the meeting-point of earth and heaven. Our faith captures the whole of who we are: body, soul, intellect and will. In this capacity our faith in Christ is far more than a mere assent to believe in the Saviour. It directs our lives far beyond the confines of earthly existence and propels us heavenwards, to eternity where we will find ultimate glory. With our souls always eager to meet Christ we are set on an earthly journey which also encompasses heaven and fulfils all the dimensions of who we are as singular lovers of Christ. "We shall be like Him because we shall see Him as He really is (I John 3).


