Father John ponders......

"Happiness cannot be travelled to, owned, earned, worn or consumed. Happiness is the spiritual experience of living every minute with love, grace, and gratitude." -- Denis Waitley

Who doesn't want a life filled with happiness? Surely it belongs to us by right. We don't want to live without meaning and purpose in our lives and we go to extraordinary lengths to make sure we are well provided for with respect to happiness. Without happiness we feel listless if not downright depressed, a life filled with drudgery and existential malaise. Too right that we try to avoid such meaningless experiences. So, we go to all lengths to fill our days with nice things and joyful experiences to alleviate unhappiness.

From time immemorial people have taken to "comfort shopping" to make themselves feel good. It makes them feel in charge of themselves and gives a sense of purpose in directing their own lives. The allure of buying stuff to fill the gap is certainly encouraged by the advertising we experience. We can be quite gullible in falling for the hype, if only we can find some happiness in the items we buy. And I'm sure that we can be honest if we admit that what we have bought doesn't make us feel good for very long. But grand scale consumerism is the order of the day and we don't want to feel left out, and it promises so much. Irrespective of the advertising claims of things being there to buy and make you whole, the real intention is to get you to buy so that companies can make large profits.

Which is where the teachings of Christ come into their own. Our quotation today, by Denis Waitley, really does open us up to a different dimension of experience and lands us in the realm of spirituality, our true being. Our cravings to buy happiness are narcissistic ploys all about ourselves, and Christ never taught that. He taught us to be one with Him and with the Father. "Living every minute with love, grace, and gratitude" is a heavenly way of living and such things have an ongoing richness in our lives. They lead us to God and other people and away from our own self-centredness. They direct our lives to seek happiness as an ultimate endeavour in the small events as well as the big events of our lives, finding God in all that we do. And God is of the Eternal, the Ultimate Happiness.

When we can recognise that cravings for the things of this world lead us out of spiritual balance and direct our attention and efforts to what is not of heaven, then we have a chance to re-balance our lives towards the Eternal. Yes, we need the things of this world to get through life, but we need a balanced approach to them so that they don't overwhelm us with unspiritual longings. Love, Grace, and Gratitude are eternal and fulfil humanity's real yearnings.
